# "Bangalow Have Your Say!" survey results

Throughout December 2015 and early January 2016, a community committee made up of the Bangalow Chamber of Commerce, Bangalow Progress Association and Bangalow Building Owners and Stakeholders Alliance, together, conducted a survey asking residents of 2479, business owners, workers and visitors to Bangalow what they like and dislike about the village, and the changes, visions and big ideas they would like to see implemented in Bangalow. Many of you may have seen this survey in your letterbox and, hopefully responded to it.

A total of 313 responses were received, the majority of which were from residents of the 2479 postcode area. The survey responses have been analysed and categorised by the community committee. 
